Thursday, September 19th, 10am-3pm **Extension Service Offers Free Soil Testing**

The Estill County Extension Service is pleased to offer a special soil testing promotion beginning September 2013. Estill County agriculture and commercial horticulture producers can receive up to 10 soil samples tested annually free of charge. Homeowners and backyard gardeners can receive up to 5 soil samples free of charge. This offer does not apply to commercial lawn care and landscaping businesses. Call us for questions about promotion limitations.

Fall is an excellent time to soil test cropland, pastures, hayfields, gardens, and lawns. Soil testing is an important lab analysis that tells you what nutrients are in your soil. If nutrient levels are too low, fertilizer or other soil amendments may be needed to achieve best plant growth. "Test, don't guess."

For each sample, we need about two cups of air-dried soil to do the test. We do offer soil sample bags and loan out soil probes. For more information about how to take a soil sample, contact us at 723-4557. Funding made possible by the Estill County Extension District Board. Offer duration is dependent upon availability of funds.

In addition, soybean producers should consider testing their fields for soybean cyst nematode (SCN) this fall. SCN can reduce yields without showing visible symptoms. Producers can split their regular soil samples and we can send one part to be tested for SCN. The Kentucky Soybean Board is covering the cost of SCN tests. Contact me for more information about properly collecting soil samples for SCN analysis.

Dry leaves, stems and roots (broken up), grass clippings, spent produce, manure and other summer plant debris should be well decomposed by spring if plowed under in fall. Work these materials into the top 5-7 inches of soil with a rototiller or shovel. Sites that are prone to erosion by wind or water over winter should be covered with straw or burlap. - Brenda Weaver

USDA Farm Service Agency reserves funds each year to make loans to socially disadvantaged applicants to buy and operate family-size farms. A socially disadvantaged farmer is one of a group whose members have been subjected to racial, ethnic, or gender prejudice because of their identity as members of the group without regard to their individual qualities. For the purposes of this program, socially disadvantaged groups have been defined as women, Blacks or African Americans, American Indians or Alaskan Natives, Hispanics, Asians, and Native Hawaiians or other Pacific Islanders.

Types of Loans •Operating loans may be used for various short and intermediate type credit needs, such as the purchase of livestock and equipment (E/R/O T/S) and annual operating expenses.

•Farm ownership loans may be used for the purchase and/or improvement of farmland and buildings. Who May Borrow

Individuals, partnerships, joint operations, corporations, limited liability companies, and cooperatives primarily and directly engaged in family-size farming operations may apply. A family size operation is considered to be one that a family can operate and manage itself.
