While mixing some pudding mix for a banana pudding the other day I thought about the brand of the pudding, JELL-O. I got to thinking, how long has Jell-O been around? As long as I can remember, so I did a little research.

My childhood days always included Jell-O; red, yellow, orange and green gelatin. It was delicious and a cool treat on a hot summer day; and it was so simple and easy to prepare.

Jell-O, As Long As I Can Remember

Jell-O, which is one of the largest selling prepared desserts had a somewhat less than auspicious beginning. In fact, it seemed for several years it might not begin at all.

Peter Cooper, inventor of the famous locomotive Tom Thumb and patron of the arts and sciences obtained the first patent for a gelatin dessert in 1845. Gelatin itself however was discovered long before then. History's first reference to it was in 1682, when a Frenchman named Denis Papin recorded his research on the subject. His experiments resulted in a method removing the glutinous material from animal bones by boiling.

Gelatin has no taste, odor, and, when combined with liquid, no color; but is pure protein. The gourmet-minded French like their foods en-gelée – and their word for it is without the final e, whether you're referring to flavored or unflavored.

Peter Cooper did nothing about his patent for a gelatin dessert, and neither did

anyone else until 50 years later, when Pearl B. Wait, a cough-medicine manufacturer in Leroy, N.Y., became bored with the cough medicine business and looked around for a new field. How he happened on Cooper's invention is not known, but in 1897 he began production of an adaptation of Cooper's gelatin dessert. The intriguing name, Jell-O, was coined by Wait's wife, Mary. Unfortunately, her inspiration for one of the most outstanding brand names in history is unknown.

There were a lot of speculations of why it was called Jell-O; such as it had to gel before it was ate or that the dessert reminded people of jelly because it shook when jelled.

Inspired as the name was, Jell-O didn't set any sales records and Wait sold the business for \$450.00 two years later to a neighbor, orator, Francis Woodward, who

had just founded a company to manufacture a cereal beverage called Grain-O.

Unsold cases of Jell-O sat in Woodward's warehouse. Then one day as he and his plant supervisor, Mr. Nico were looking at the unsold boxes, he told him he would sell the whole Jell-O business for \$35.00. Mr. Nico smiled and said, "Thanks a lot, but no thanks."

Shortly thereafter, Woodward had cause to rejoice, and Nico to weep, because at the turn of the century the long neglected dessert suddenly caught on with the public and made up for lost time. In 1902 sales shot up to \$250,000, and four years later they soared to just under the million-dollar mark. You know the rest of the story.

It is untold today; Jell-O's net worth. In 1925, Jell-O joined forces with General Foods Corporation. They have many, many products on the market today.

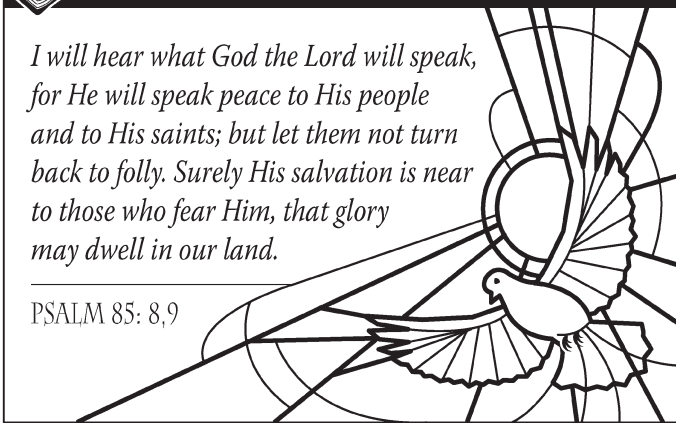

Everyone is welcome at all of these services.

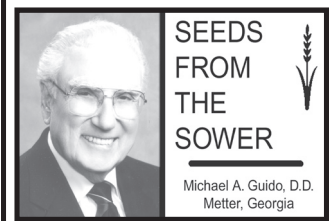

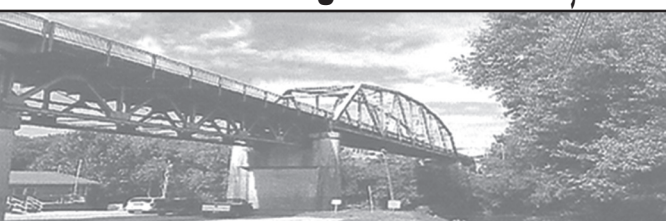
