He likes arresting Bob and handcuffing him. He had a blast pretending Bob was the bad guy. Of course his Papa Bob goes along with what he wants to do!

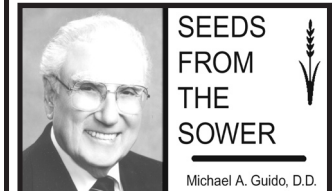
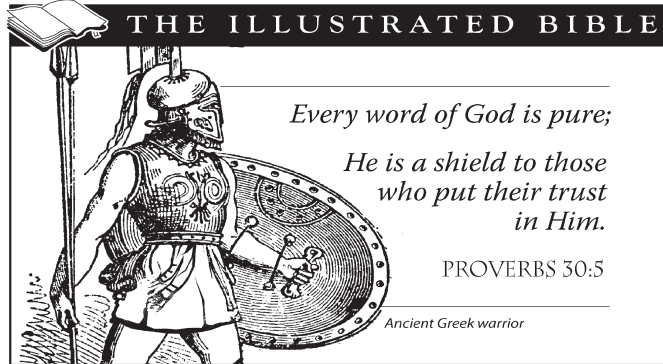

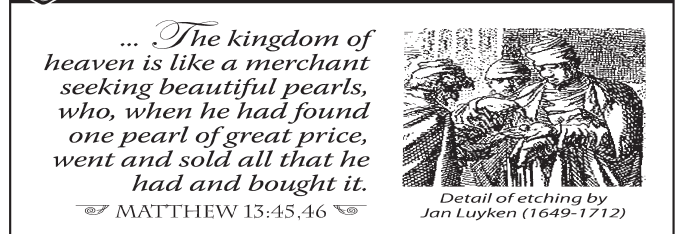
