The Lord's Day?

"If thou turn away thy foot from the sabbath, from doing thy pleasure on my holy day; and call the sabbath a delight, the holy of the Lord, honourable; and shalt honour him, not doing thine own ways, nor finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking thine own words: Then shalt thou delight thyself in the Lord; and I will cause thee to ride upon the high places of the earth, and feed thee with the heritage of Jacob thy father: for the mouth of the Lord hath spoken it," (Isaiah 58:13-14).

Throughout the Old Testament there are many times when God rebuked Israel for their misuse of the Sabbath day. We may wonder why it was so important to the Lord to have Israel remember and observe this special day. More than just a day of rest, it was a day to they thought of it, and their observance of it, showed the condition of their relationship with God.

Just as the body needed to rest, so did the spirit. Jesus said in **Mark**

2:27, "The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath." God knew that man needed to rest from his labors, both physically, and spiritually. "Speak thou also unto the children of Israel, saying, Verily my sabremember the Lord and what God had done for them. The way that baths ye shall keep: for it is a sign between me and you throughout your generations; that ye may know that I am the Lord that doth sanctify you. Ye church for sports, or some other thing that they like. I think that we can shall keep the sabbath therefore; for it is holy unto you: every one that defileth it shall surely be put to death: for whosoever doeth any work therein,

that soul shall be cut off from among his people," (Exodus 31:13-14).

If they didn't like to keep the sabbath, it was because they liked the things of the world better. The lure to work, to buy and sell, was strong for those who loved riches. As they trusted in their wealth, the trust in God suffered for it. They, like we, had to make a choice as to who they trusted in, themselves, or in God. Could God really provide for them? I have seen those who farmed, but didn't let crops, or the threat of rain keep them from church. Did they lose by putting God first? No, rather than lose, they prospered.

A person might say that we are not under the law and do not have to keep the sabbath. True, but we still need to rest and to learn God's Word. It is usually easy to spot those who put the world before the Lord. They are not strong in faith, or obedience to the Lord. To them faith is a strange idea.

When work is not the problem, play often is. People will skip see from the scriptures, Old Testament and New Testament, that God was not joking when he commanded that we put him first in our lives.


