A Big Boulder!

Sometimes I get a little off track and don't write about outdoor stuff. This week has nothing to do with the outdoors, but a story that I want to tell. This is a story of a 1200 pound boulder and the power of a mighty God!

The past several months a friend of mine, Adam Jackson, and me have been trying to build a business! We have been landscaping and putting in patios all over Lexington. We have even been bidding a few commercial landscape jobs.

We got the bid for a hospital job in Breathitt County. This job required seven big boulders from Knoxville, Tennessee, as part of the landscaping! When I say, big boulders, the weight range is between 600 and 1800 pounds. The area where the boulders went made for some tight work.

The first three boulders we got in with a bobcat. We had a plan to pick up the final four boulders and get them in with a bobcat. That was the plan! I had to pick up the last four boulders a week later, but by the time I got back, a wall was being built with a single door. Needless to say I had a little bit of panic on how we were going to get the other four boulders in the courtyard!

A few weeks later, the call came saying the walls were done and we could move boulders in. They also said be very careful not to hit the walls through the small hallway! The boulders had to be moved ASAP and Adam couldn't make it. So, I give my good friend Jordan Covey a call to help me move some big rock!

We arrived in Breathitt and went to work! We moved each 600 pounder down the hall then carefully rolled them through the small single door to the courtyard. Then it was time to get the 1200 pounder down the hall. We staged it by the little door!

We had all the 600 pounders rolled up on pallets. Then we had to turn the pallet jack sideways to get it through the little door! Now the challenge was getting boulders over the loose rock base used in the landscape. So we took sheets of plywood, laid it on rock, and rolled each 600 pounder in place.

The 1200 pounder had us a little worried! Let me rephrase, A LOT worried! I figured it would be impossible for Jordan and I to get through the little door! Jordan didn't think it would fit without ripping the door jamb off and smashing a
