October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month



In an effort to increase awareness and promote prevention the Estill County Health Department and Marcum & Wallace Memorial Hospital are teaming up to sponsor Women's Health Day on Wednesday, October 30, 2013 at the Estill County Health Department. If you are a woman over the age of 40 you should get a PAP test and mammogram every year. Cancer screenings, including PAP tests and clinical breast exams will be provided. Appointments will be scheduled for women needing mammograms at Marcum-Wallace Hospital.

The health department and the hospital are reaching out to ladies between 40 and 64 years of age who are uninsured or underinsured and have never had a mammogram or a PAP test or who have not had one in the last 5 years. **You could be eligible for a FREE or low-cost mammogram!** In 2013 we want to make sure that all ladies have these tests. We are offering \$20 Wal-Mart cards to all ladies in the target group that have never had a mammogram or a PAP test and offering \$10 Wal-Mart cards for ladies in the target group that have not had a mammogram or a PAP test in the last 5 years.
