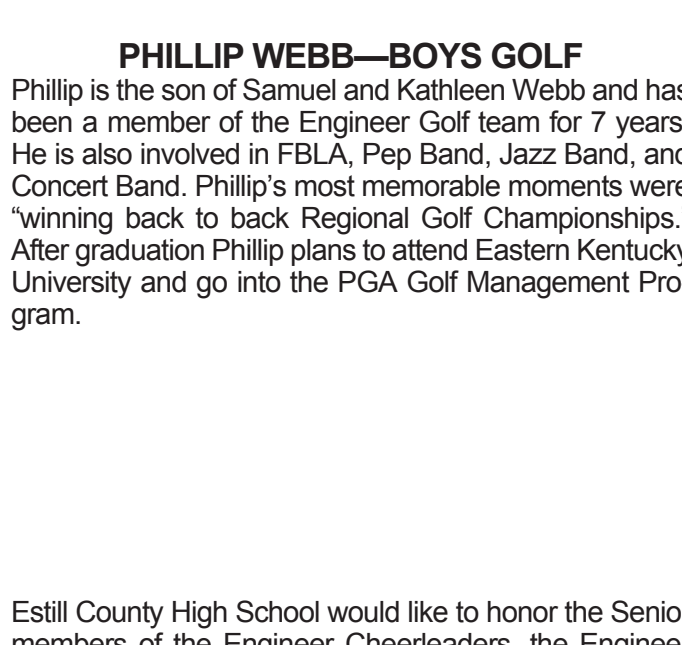
BENTON KIRBY—BOYS GOLF
