One of the last garden chores of the season is preparing our strawberry plants for winter. Strawberry plants have already set their buds for next spring's flowers and the crop can be lost unless winter conditions.

Winter Care For Strawberry Plants

ry plant's flower buds can ber. be damaged at temperatures right out of the ground.

Mulching from extreme low temperatures, minimize soil heaving and decrease excessive dryuntil plants are dormant before you pile on the mulch. 
