Life Story: How Your History Can Help You

Do you remember when you met your spouse? How much did you pay for your first house? What was your experience like when you went to school or started your

first job? Perhaps these things seem ordinary to you. But what if you were asking your parents or grandparents these questions? Would their stories seem uninteresting? Most likely not! Many of us wish we knew more about our family history and family experiences.

Life story is an account of the series of events that make up your life and define who you are. This account starts at birth and continues throughout life. But it's an account that very few of us document over time. No one is too young or too old to start writing down their life story. But the sooner you start, the more accurate or detailed your stories will be. Life story can be captured many ways – journaling, photographs, voice recordings and formal life story programs. Recording and sharing life story is important because it helps explain to you

and to others who you are, where you've been, how you got there, where you are now and even where and what you will be doing in the future. Writing and sharing life story also promotes an active brain, quality relationships, mental healthiness and legacy building.
