## Tandy Crawford Jr., 80



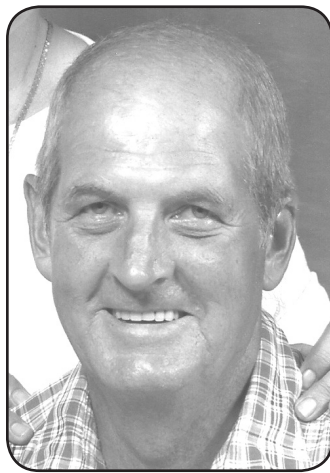
Tandy Crawford Jr., age 80, widower of Betty Claunch Crawford passed away Monday, March 3, 2014.

 Miller allegedly told the officer that he sold the television to Luke Willis and the blueray player to Jamie Witt.

The officer said that Miller also admitted to filling out the Kentucky citation in

an attempt to deceive Pizza Hut. Miller was involved in an accident and arrested for driving under the influence on February 28, 2014. Until recently, Miller had worked at Pizza Hut.

The place of Shearer's arrest was listed on the citation as Pizza Hut.

Police Chief Brad Smith refused to comment on the allegedly forged citation, only saying that it was not one of the city police department's citations.

Shearer and Miller were arraigned Monday in Estill District Court. They each pleaded not-guilty to the charges made against them. They will return to court again on March 19 for a preliminary hearing.

Bail for each of them was set at \$25,000 cash.

A bench warrant was also served on Shearer by Officer Sturniolo. The warrant was signed by Judge B. Oliver in Jessamine County. It states that Shearer was found guilty of fourth degree assault (domestic violence) on 11/30/2010. The warrant was issued because it says Shearer failed to appear.
