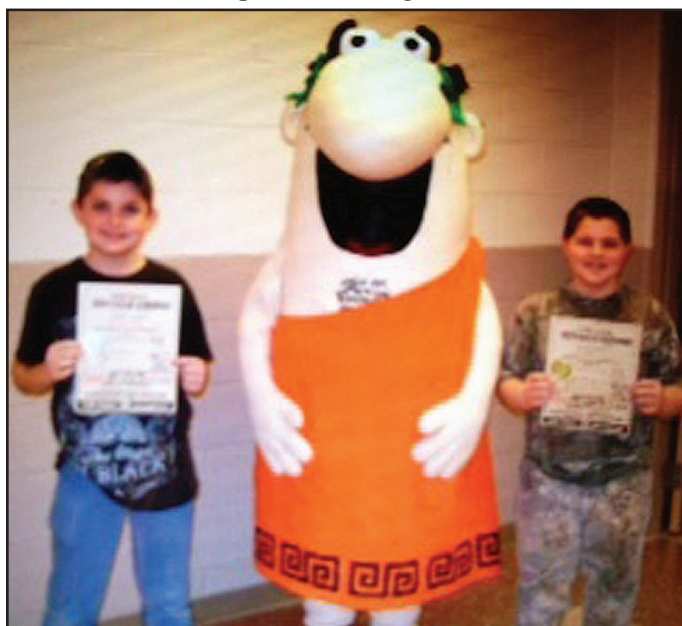
Manns, the daughter of
