Conservation District Sponsors Environmental Cleanup

The Estill County Conservation District will utilize a \$2,500 Environmental Grant from the Kentucky Division of Conservation Soil and Water Conservation Commission to sponsor an "Environmental Cleanup" for Estill County residents only, at the local landfill.

The program begins Monday, April 28, 2014. If funds permit, the program will continue through Friday, May 2, 2014; however, if funds are depleted, the program could end without further notice.

Due to the limited funds the program will be limited to ONE voucher per household and/or Estill County address. Each voucher is good for ONE visit to the landfill. The program will not include commercial waste or tires.

In order to participate in the Environmental Cleanup, you must obtain a Voucher at the Estill County Conservation District located at 1505 Richmond Road, Irvine, KY between the hours of 8:00 am - 4:30 pm. For further information call the office at 606-723-5104.

Soil testing is a special chemical analysis that provides a guideline for lime and fertilizer needs of soils. Knowing exactly what the soils need is critical to growing crops, forages, vegetables, flowers, trees, shrubs, lawns, and various plants.

Soil testing service is available to every Kentucky citizen through the University of Kentucky Agricultural Experiment Station and the Cooperative Extension Service. Tent Caterpillars Active

Warmer weather has triggered emergence of the eastern tent caterpillar, an important early-season insect pest of ornamental landscape plants. Eastern tent caterpillars are active on a variety of deciduous hosts, including wild cherry, apple and crabapple but will also feed on peach, pear, plum, hawthorn and some shade trees.

For homeowners, control in the landscape is best accomplished when webs are first noticed and the larvae are small. If nests are within reach, they can be removed with a stick, broom, or pruning shears. Ideally this should be done in the evening, when the larvae are inside the nest.

Insecticidal sprays are also effective. Some registered products include Bt (*Bacillus thuringiensis*), Sevin, Bonide Eight, Bayer Advanced Garden Multi-Insect Killer, Ortho MAX Bug B Gone, and pyrethroids. Apply treatments to the nest and adjoining foliage of plants where the caterpillars are feeding. As always, read and follow the insecticide label. Dousing nests with gasoline and setting them on fire is dangerous and can harm the tree.
