

# Police Activities

The Estill County Sheriff's Department is investigating a theft from a residence on Twin Creek Road.

Lynne Parks reported to Deputy Randy Farthing a theft of building materials from her home on April 26.

Farthing said that someone had taken copper pipe and wiring from the home. They also damaged plumbing and electrical wiring.

He stated that someone had accessed the home through a crawl space.

A suspect will face charges of theft by unlawful taking and criminal mischief.

Another theft was reported by Shaye McGee of Cow Creek Road, Ravenna on April 26.

McGee reported that \$200 in money and jewelry valued at \$800 was stolen from her residence. More items may be added to the list of stolen items.

An engraved case knife and two wedding bands were among the stolen jewelry.

The investigation continues by Deputy Farthing. Irvine Police Dept.

Jonathon Dixon, 22, of Clay Isaacs Road, Irvine was arrested April 27 by Officer Sam Hensley on a bench warrant. The warrant says Dixon failed to appear in district court for operating on a suspended or revoked license.

Jonathan F. Harrison, 28, of Short Street, Irvine was charged on Saturday afternoon by Officer Hensley with theft by unlawful taking under \$500. The citation states that Harrison and Natasha Ann Rogers, 26, also of Short Street, were invited to 268 Broadway. After they left, the homeowners discovered a missing Ipad. IPD stopped the vehicle and Harrison allegedly had the Ipad in his possession. The Ipad was valued at \$400.00. Rogers was also charged with theft of the Ipad.

The pair had also been arrested on Friday for misdemeanor theft.

The citations state that IPD received a call that the couple were walking through the festival area and stealing items from closed vendor tents. Officer Hensley said that IPD recovered various items in a baby carrier which were similar to the vendor items.

served on Jonathan E. Dixon, Wagersville Road on 4/27 by Officer John Sturniolo. The bench warrant was issued for failure to appear for an arraignment on forgery, third degree.

A bench warrant was served on Jonathan Dixon, Timberline Trail on 4/27 by Officer Sturniolo. The warrant was issued for failure to appear for speeding 17mph over limit and operating on suspended or revoked license.

Jonathan Dixon, 22, of Wagersville Road, was arrested 4/27 by Officer Sturniolo and charged with fleeing and evading on foot and alcohol intoxication.

The citation states that Dixon was at vendors' area of mushroom festival after hours and ran when the officer activated lights and siren.

Albert Ray Hall, 43, of Millers Creek Road, was charged 4/26 by Officer Karl Rifenbark with operating motor vehicle under the influence and failure to produce insurance card. The citation states that Hall was involved in a single vehicle accident on Laurel Steret with no injuries.
