Species available: White Amur (Grass Carp) 10", \$12.00 each; Channel Catfish 5-7", .50 each; Coppernose Bluegill 2-3", .50 each; Hybrid Sunfish 2-3", .50 each; Largemouth Bass 6-7", \$4.00 each; Fathead Minnows 2", \$9.00 per lb.; Koi Ornamental Fish 6+", \$7.00 each are also available. A transportation container for the fish will be provided.

Mr. Ken Jacobs, Whiskers Catfish Farm, will be here on delivery day to answer any questions you might have concerning the condition of your pond, problems you might have with fish living in the pond, or the number, or variety of fish needed, to properly stock your pond.

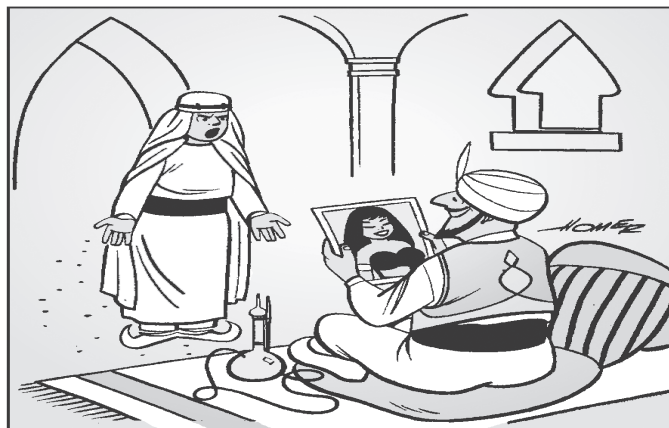
Monday, May 19th, 9-11:30am
