"I was putting out the feed, when the sucker came charging at me like a locomotive. He danged near got me!"


"So, how'd you get away?"

The recent explosion in there, only 4 or 5 was on


I got moved to Powell both paramedics said I need to go to the hospital. But, administrator said no to me going to hospital.
