"Me and God are getting ready to cross Harrodsburg Road", I laughed.

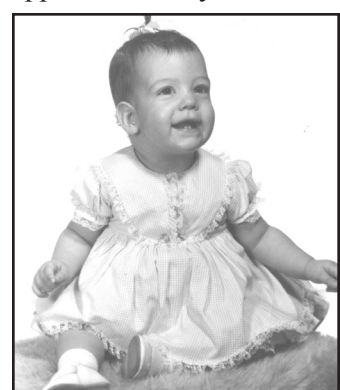
"Well ya'll better come on", she replied with laughter, "cause my plane landed
