# Couple is arrested for using shopping cart to shoplift detergent

A young couple faces felony charges after

The female told Freeman they had planned to sell the laundry detergent for \$3 a bottle at an Irvine business.

Freeman said the shopping cart was valued at \$300.

Because the total value of the detergent, fabric softener, and shopping cart was valued at more than \$500, the charges against the young couple are felonies. The punishment for the felony is one to five years in

Cornett and Plowman were each charged with theft by unlawful taking, shoplifting.

Bail information and court dates were not available.
