

The loss of habitat coupled with fur prices dropping has led to a steep decline in quail populations. Groups like People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals PETA have contributed to the destruction of the fur industry. Since trapping dropped off, the quail predators populations have risen and quail numbers have dropped.
