College football season in Kentucky is six weeks away, right? Wrong.

Tis half-dozen Fridays away. In Bowling Green, Western Kentucky Hilltoppers host Bowling Green University (Ohio), game moved to Friday night, August 29 (for TV - CBS Sports Net).

CAULEY-STEIN PROTEGE'?

Six-feet-11, 240 pound bundle of man-child talent, Karl Anthony Towns will be 19 years old in November. Kid has the right stuff to be a Kentucky basketball poster boy on fan-love plateau with Jamal Mashburn, Kyle Macy and the Unforgettable.
