

Estill Boys Golf Team Off To Another Great Start

The ECHS boys golf team traveled to Eagle Trace Golf Course in Morehead Friday August 1st for their first tournament of the season.

Estill County came in 4th place out of 14 teams with a team total of 327. Mason County, a top 10 team in the state won the tournament with a team total of 317. Estill was led by Senior Andrew Farmer's 2 over par 74 which was good enough to take 4th place as an individual. Senior Ryan

Freeman posted a score of 83, followed by Senior Jay Winkler's 85; 7th grader Joe Benton's 85; Junior Makane Short's 93; and Senior Caleb Click's 105.

On Saturday, August 2nd, the boy's team hosted their 14th annual invitational. The tournament was a great success due, in large part, to all the local sponsors.

With a great score of 297, Estill came in 3rd place to Mason County, the same team that beat them in More-

head. Mason proved why they are one of the top teams in the state by posting an unbelievable score of 285. Somerset came in 2nd place with a score of 295.

Senior Andrew Farmer once again led Estill on this day with a great round of 68, well enough for 3rd place as an individual. Senior Caleb Click posted a wonderful score of 74 followed by Senior Ryan Freeman's solid 75, Senior Jay Winkler's 80, 7th grader Joe Benton's 81, and

Junior Makane Short's 87. On Monday August 4th, Estill played in the North Laurel Jaguar Classic at the very tough London Crooked Creek golf course.

Estill placed 7th out of 20 teams, with a score of 338. The scoring was as follows: Andrew Farmer 82, Ryan Freeman 85, Jay Winkler 85, Joe Benton 86, Makane Short 94, and Caleb Click 101.

On Saturday August 9th, Estill traveled to rival Powell County's tournament and

came away with the championship trophy. The boys posted a score of 309 which was good enough to beat runner-up Montgomery County by 6 shots. As he has all season long, Senior Andrew Farmer led the Engineers with a one under par 71, making him the overall tournament winner. This made Andrew's second tournament out of four with scores below par. All of the seniors stepped up in this tournament knowing it would be the last time that they would have the opportunity to beat their rival, Powell County, at their home course.

Ryan Freeman and Jay Winkler posted great scores of 77 and Caleb Click carded an 84. 7th grader Joe Benton shot an 88, and Junior Makane Short finished with

a round of 82.
