Sidewalk Improvements Underway

Sidewalk improvements are underway in Estill County on KY 52 (River Drive) and KY 2461 (Broadway) in Irvine. New handicap access ramps will be installed. Sidewalks may be closed in certain areas while the work is ongoing, and some lane closures on the streets may also be necessary. The work is scheduled to take approximately six to eight weeks to complete.

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Night Time Delays Possible Along Mountain Parkway

Night time (9 p.m. - 7 a.m) travelers on the Mountain Parkway can expect delays and even double-lane closures between milepoints 95 and 98 during the period between Wednesday, August 27 and Wednesday, September 3, 2014.

Closures are necessary for crack sealing of pavement joints, a preventative process that aids in preserving the life of the pavement, reducing future maintenance costs.

Crack sealing is scheduled for the week days with no weekend work anticipated. Work could continue onto the Exit 96 ramps (to KY 627 - Paris to Winchester), and all work is subject to change depending on weather, emergencies and other factors beyond the control of the Department of Highways.
