After planting, homeowners should keep the new lawn consistently moist but not so wet that puddles appear. To help with continued growth, individuals may want to add a nitrogen fertilizer about one month after germination. The grass should not be mowed until it becomes one-third taller cess to water and nutrients than the desired mowing height.


