Estill Native Named to ECU Educational Talent Search Position

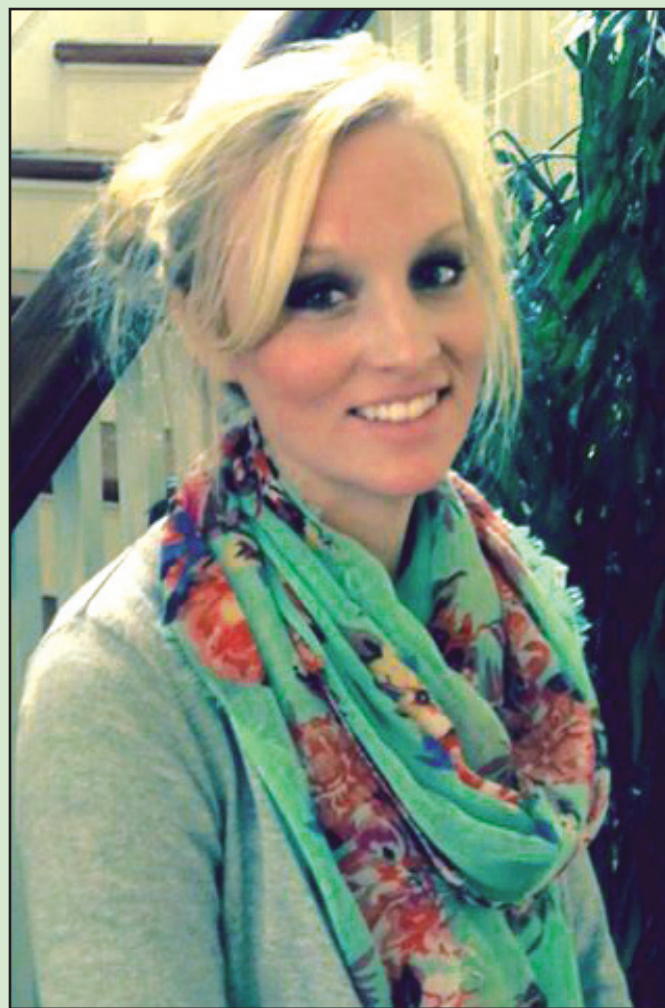
Ms. Ashley Flynn has been named as Educational Coordinator for the Educational Talent Search (ETS) Program at Eastern Kentucky University (EKU).
