Christmas morning I'd dial 3-3831 on the old party line to squeal into the phone, "Kelley! What did Santa bring?" I loved hearing the contents of her stocking, always overflowing with 'Little Kettles' and lip gloss. Now every Christmas morning, I find myself compelled to dial that number, but the party line is long gone and Kelley isn't at 3-3831 anymore.

Fast forward to Labor Day 2014 and seventeen Fridays until Christmas! I realize we can never go back, but for a brief moment, in the hustle and bustle of my busy day at school and the heat of an August afternoon, I sure do wish for beginning a new school year AFTER Labor Day, plaid jumpers, a party line and...the good ol' days again.

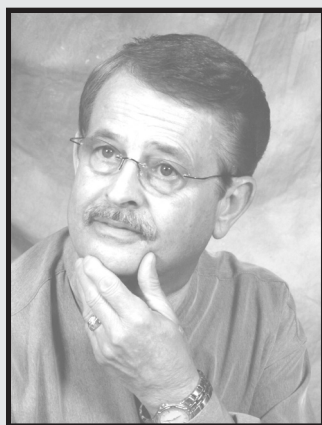
