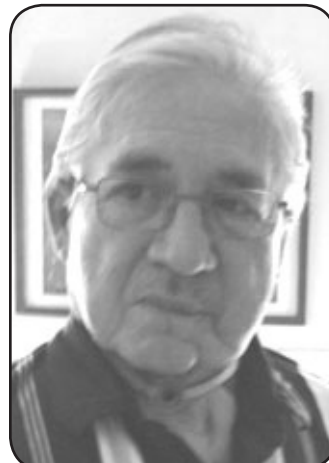
Steven W. Hensley, 65
