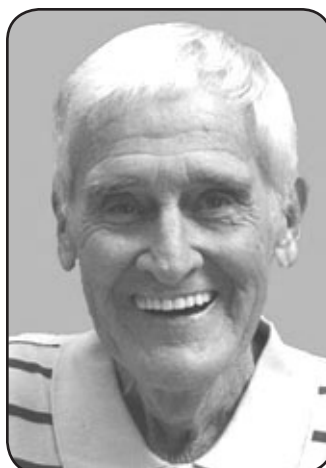
Sunday, September 14, 2014 William T. "Bill" Orme, 86
