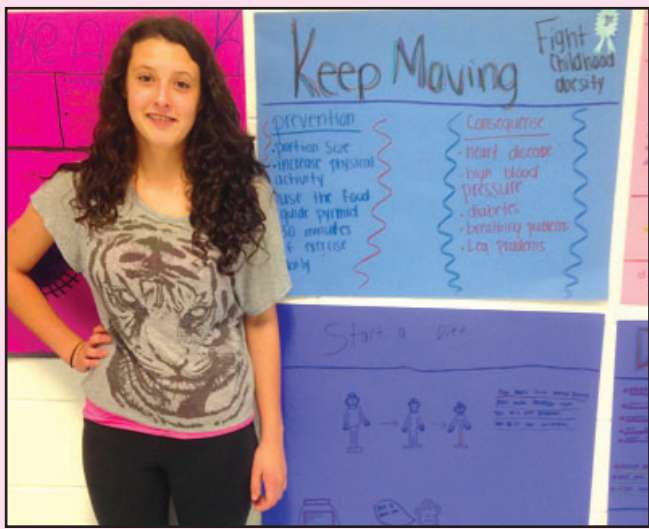

Elite Jumpers Gear Up For Upcoming Season

The Estill Elite Jumpers have been gearing up all summer for the upcoming season. This year's team consists of 14 jumpers (with 13 returning jumpers and one newcomer). The Estill Elite Jumpers is a unique sport that continues to gain local support. In fact, it is the only county-wide sports team with jumpers ranging from 4th grade to 9th grade. It is an intense sport that is lead by Jodi Sims (founder) and Assistant Coach Elizabeth Renner. The big change for the upcoming season is it is no longer a winter/spring sport. It is now a year-round sport. These jumpers are truly athletes and practice twice a week. Jumpers can burn up to 750 calories per hour. In fact, ten minutes of jumping rope is as effective as 30 minutes of jogging. Other sports team use jumping rope as a way of conditioning.

The jumpers competed in two competitions in Ohio during last season. This year they will have the opportunity to participate in 3 competitions in Ohio and Indiana. Also, folks in the community will have the opportunity to see them in action with more local performances being planned this year. The jumpers will have their first performance of the season on Sunday, Oct. 12th at 2pm at the Choo Choo Park in Ravenna as part of the community's "Second Sunday" event.
