It's pumpkin time in Kentucky. Everywhere you look there are displays in businesses, yards and porches decorated with mums, bales of straw, and pumpkins.

While in Pigeon Forge this past weekend, I visited the "Harvest Moon," pumpkin stand. Chuck, the owner, said there are eighteen varieties of pumpkins; the

star being the white pumpkin. The white ones are very popular this year. Another popular one is the "The Cinderella," which looks like a tangerine and are stackable. There are older heirlooms of pumpkins like the Marina de Chioggia from Italy, and there are brand new varieties just hitting the market like Peanut Pumpkin, which looks to be covered with peanut shells. Imagine that!

The largest pumpkin at the stand was the "Atlantic Giant," according to Chuck, the owner.

The "Giant" lives up to its name. According to the Guinness Book, the largest pumpkin grown in 2013 was an Atlantic giant beast that tipped the scales at just over a ton.

There was one pumpkin

called "The Fairy Tale," and "Turks Turban" which is easily recognized by its unique shape.

The smallest pumpkins are called "field trip" pumpkins; they are used for arts and crafts. Younger children have fun painting and decorating them.

Pumpkins can be made into many things. They are used for carving and decorating and the best part is for cooking and baking.

My favorites are: pumpkin roll, pumpkin cake, and pumpkin pie. Also, there are pumpkin muffins, pumpkin butter, and pumpkin cheese cake to name a few desserts.
