

Applications Being Taken For 2015 Rogers Scholars

The Center for Rural Development is accepting applications now through Jan. 31 for the 2015 summer session of the Rogers Scholars youth leadership program.

Rogers Scholars is an intensive one-week summer leadership program for upcoming high school juniors within The Center's 45-county primary service area in Southern and Eastern Kentucky. The program emphasizes the development of technological skills and builds in participants a sense of leadership, an entrepreneurial spirit, and a commitment to rural Kentucky.

The Rogers Scholars program is an experience of a lifetime," said 2014 Rog-

ers Scholars graduate Kyle Back. "I don't think there is a better program in Kentucky. Rogers Scholars changed my life."

Students apply during their sophomore year in high school and are selected through a competitive screening process to attend one of two summer leadership sessions of the Rogers Scholars program.

"I have seen first-hand how the Rogers Scholars program can change the lives of youth in Southern and Eastern Kentucky," said Lonnie Lawson, President and CEO of The Center for Rural Development. "The program provides Scholars with real-life experiences in

fields such as healthcare and technology, and gives them a chance to understand all that is available to them as a career path, including starting their own business. What's more, the program gives them access to scholarship opportunities that enables them to continue on with their education."

The program, launched by The Center in 1998, provides leadership and exclusive college scholarship opportunities for high school students to develop their full potential as the region's next generation of business and entrepreneurial leaders.

"The community service component of the program is very important to the future

growth and sustainability of the Appalachian region of Kentucky," said Delaney Stephens, community liaison and youth programs coordinator for The Center. "The Rogers Scholars program provides our youth with essential leadership skills that serve as the foundation of future academic and entrepreneurial endeavors, and inspires them to pursue their career right at home in Kentucky."

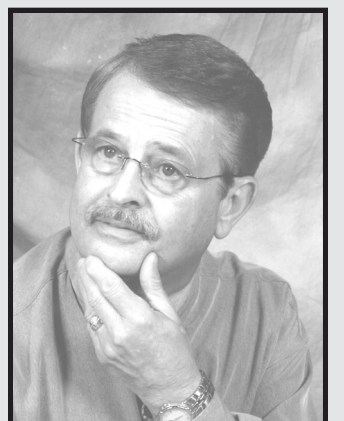
