

# Grand jury returns eight indictments

Henry allegedly had trailer axles in his possession between May 12 and 14, 2014 which had been reported stolen by Don Fletcher.

Morris conducted the investigation into this Class D felony.

Billy Reid Metcalf, 46, of Paint Lick, Ky. was indicted for first degree assault, a Class B felony.

The indictment says on Sept. 27, Metcalf caused serious injury to Dustin Young. He used a knife to stab Young seven times.

Punishment for a Class B felony is ten to twenty years

in prison.

Deputy Randy Farthing investigated the stabbing.

Matthew Knopp, 27, of Millers Creek Road, Ravenna was named in a 30-count indictment. The 30 charges are the same, criminal possession of a forged instrument, second degree.

The indictment states that between August 29 and September 4 of this year, Knopp illegally wrote and cashed 0 checks belonging to Wayne Knopp.

The offense is a Class D felony. M. Knopp could be sentenced to serve one to five years for each charge.

Deputy Ethan Jordan was the investigating officer.

Irvine Police Captain Michael Gross served the indictment warrant on M. Knopp on Sunday, Oct. 26.

James Kerry Gilvin, 55, of Lexington was indicted for first degree burglary, third degree terroristic threatening, first degree criminal mischief, and intimidating a participant in the legal process.

The indictment says that Gilvin entered the home

of Anthony Smith in Estill County while armed with a deadly weapon.

It says Gilvin broke into Smith's window and kicked his front door. It also states that he threatened to kill Smith.

First degree robbery is a Class B felony. Terroristic threatening is a Class B misdemeanor.

The other two charges are Class D felonies.

The investigating officer is Deputy Doc Morris.

Christy Henry, 29, of Blanche Court, Irvine, was indicted for two counts of making false statements to prevent reduction of benefits over \$100.

The indictment says that between December, 2012 through February 2014, Henry failed to report the income of her and her spouse while receiving benefits through the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP). The indictment states that Henry was

overpaid by \$5,099.00 in SNAP benefits.

Also between August 1, 2013 and February 28, 2014, the indictment says that Henry failed to report income which resulted in an overpayment of \$9,104.88 to the Medicare program.

OIG Special Investigator II Flo Brown presented the investigation to the Estill Grand Jury.

Henry's alleged offenses are Class D felonies.
