The winner of the poster contest was James Cohenour.

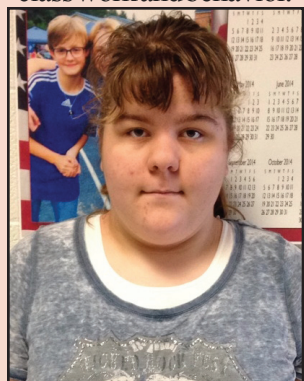
James is in 8th grade, and he is the son of Chuck and Connie Sue Cohenour.
