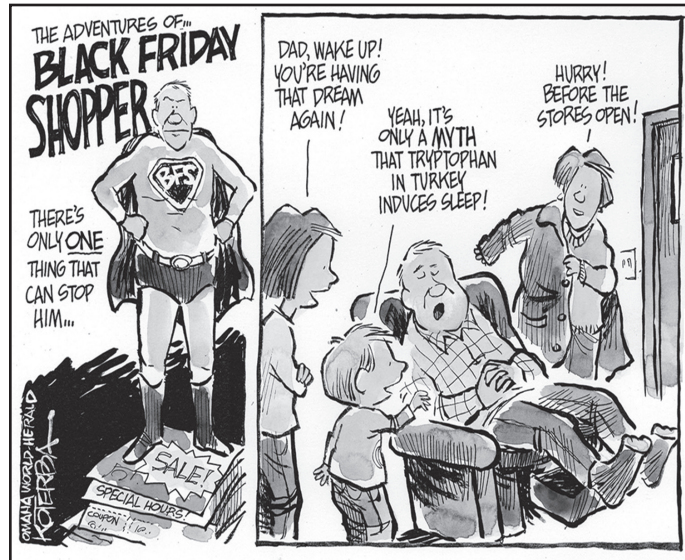
A driver is transferred to UK after wreck, Sun.
