tive young children, who are apt to put just about anything in their mouths, and curious cats might choke on fibrous poinsettia foliage. Therefore it is a good practice to put poinsettias and all other nonedible plants out of children's and pets' reach.

Poinsettias will remain beautiful far beyond the holiday season when cared for properly. Keep these tips in mind: 1) choose a plant with small, tightly clustered yellow buds in the center and crisp, bright, undamaged foliage; 2) at home, put the poinsettia in a room with bright, natural light.
