The Realities of Hell Are by BOB CASEY, Preacher Church of Christ, 262 Broadway, Irvine, KY

In the most recent post most gospel preachers, when conducting a week's meeting would ask at least two of the days to present the biblical topic concerning hell. Today the subject is hardly heard unless it is used in slang language. Why is this? First, because this is the way Satan wants it. Secondly, because it is a subject this the unsaved world dreads the most, because in reality they know that unless they repent and obey the gospel this is where they will end up. The translations of the New Testament used the term in the Hebrew language from sheol which means the place of the dead. But the real word for the eternal place of punishment for the unrepentant sinner is Gehenna, the place for eternal retribution for all evil men. Revelation 20:10-15 tells of this awful place. So sadly, whether one believes in such a place, or not, it will not change one word in God's book. The rich man described in **Luke 16:25** certainly believed in torment, but he was powerless to make a change then, for he had used his life on earth never preparing for death, but still it came to him anyway. Hebrews 9:27 says it will also happen to us as well. A short reading of **II Peter 2-9** should be enough to scare one into thinking seriously about the dangers of eternal damnation. In Matthew 25:46 this place of Gehenna is said to be everlasting. Surely one would think seriously, knowing that such a place is awaiting all sinful men. Again, I don't think at all that man desires to go there, but that some day before they die they will make the necessary changes to die in a forgiven state. But again, we let the devil lead us into thinking that we have plenty of time, but most of the time this is false thinking, because death may come suddenly and we have not time to obey the Lord unto salvation, not time to meet with the Lord's people in worship, the time to joyfully sing the songs of Him, no time to eat the Lord's appear in remembering His death, burial, and resurrection, not time for any thing but death.

As a preacher, as a believer in all of God's word, I urge you, I compel you, obey the gospel while it is today. Give the rest of your life in doing God's will. 
