

# Engineers Remain Undefeated In District, Beat Owsley, 60-48

The Estill County Engineers boys basketball team ran their district record to a perfect 5-0 with a victory over Owsley County on Friday night.

**Estill, 60 – Owsley, 48**

Even though their seven game win streak came to an end earlier in the week against Lewis County, the Engineers came to work against the Owls and with an impressive second half that kept their district win streak alive.

With Estill's inside muscle of Chipper Hitchcock, Caleb Click, and Deron Miller all saddled with two first half fouls, the Engineers would continue to carve apart Owsley's full court pressure and hit 6

three pointers against their zone defense to keep things all even at the end of the first half, 25-25.

An impressive defensive performance in the third quarter would hold Owsley to only two points and see Estill take over the game and win this one going away, 60-48.

Caleb Bonny would score 13 of his game high 18 points in the first half.

Other scoring: M. Bishop-16 pts, T. Jones-11pts, C. Hitchcock-8 pts, C. Click-4 pts, J. Benton-3 pts. Estill would hit 16-19 from the free throw line.

**Lewis, 71 – Estill, 61**

Estill would see a seven game win streak end earlier in the week at the hands of Lewis County.

The Engineers would

not go down without a fight as they rallied to score 29 points in the fourth quarter only to come up on the short end of this one, 71-61.

# Lady Engineers Win Two On The Road, Improve To 12-9

The Estill County Lady Engineers season continues to get better as they came up winners in two road contests this week. An important district win over Owsley County and a tough win in old Memorial Gym against Hazard puts the Lady 'Neers record at a season best three games above the .500 mark. Winners of 6 of their last 8 games, the Ladies look to be gathering momentum for a run at the 56th District Tournament in late February.

**Estill, 64 – Owsley, 48**

On Friday night, the Engineer Nation travelled to Booneville for district action against Owsley County. The Lady Engineers were looking to improve their district record to 2-3 with a win.

Owsley's height and inside game seemed to bother the Lady 'Neers in the first quarter but the ladies played hard and kept the score even at 19.

In the second quarter, Estill decided to fight with pressure, both offensively and on the defensive end. Estill would take advantage of the open looks they would get from their transition offense and continuous full court pressure would "turn over" Owsley County and keep their bigs nullified. Estill would dominate the second quarter and find themselves with a 38-27 lead at the half.

Estill would give them

much of the same in the second half and come away with an impressive 64-48 victory.

This game without a doubt was the best the Lady Engineers have played all year long. Everything seemed to be clicking offensively as they shot a season best 46% from the field and a blistering 8-14 from three point range.

A 14-23 outing from the charity stripe would keep Estill's heads out of the clouds, but definitely an impressive performance from the Lady Engineers on this night.

Seven ladies managed to scratch the scoring column in this "team" win with Kenedy Flynn leading the way with 28 pts, 4 stl, K. Treadway-9 pts (2-3 3's) 3 ast, B. Hall-8 pts, 3 reb, 3 ast, J. Rose-6 pts, 6 reb, S. Danyeur-6pts, 6 reb, T. Young-6 pts, 4 stl, A. Reed-1 pt, 2 reb.

**Estill, 62 – Hazard, 44**

After a late night win at Owsley County, the Lady Engineers would have little time to celebrate as they travelled to Hazard for an early afternoon game.

A late night, a long drive, and an early game time, the ladies would turn this into a "grind it out affair" against a physical-and may I say, "dirty"- Hazard team that was obviously outclassed by the ladies from Estill.

Outscoring Hazard by 17 points in the third quarter,

Estill would turn a 7 point halftime lead into a dominating 62-44 win, and the ladies would see themselves earn their 12th win of the season matching the win total of the last two years combined.
