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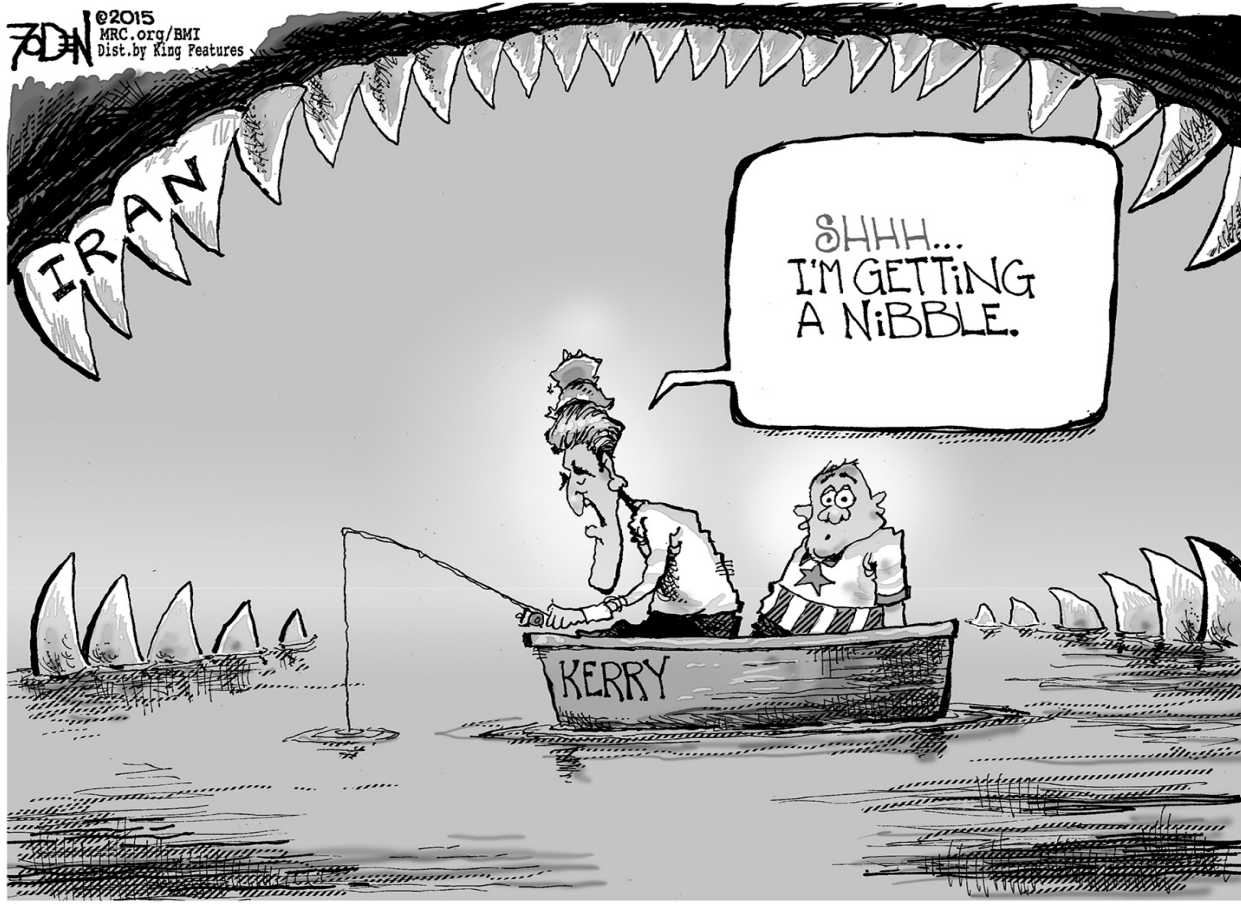

Estill EMA & Others

Estill County Critical Water Shortage and Boil Water Advisory

Critical Water Shortage and Boil Water Advisory is still in effect for all residents of Estill County.

Currently there is an estimated 500 Estill County residents without water and many more experiencing low water pressure. If you are out of water you may pick water up at the Estill County Fair Barn from 10am-8pm today. The water distribution center gave out over 8,000 gallons of water to residents yesterday.

Please be patient and conserve water. The more we conserve the faster everyone will have water again. Any water used for consumption must be boiled for at least 3 minutes.

This critical water shortage was caused by the river bank slipping above the water intake into the water treatment plant. This caused the intake to not function properly because it was covered in mud and debris. The blow out system that is used to blow debris away from the intake was also taken out by the river bank slip when a tree fell on the blowout hose disconnecting it. Divers were called in yesterday morning and they were able to clean the mud and debris away from the intake as well as repair the blowout hose. After water receded in Station Camp Creek an 8inch main break was located. This highly contributed to the water shortage as well. As of 4:00pm yesterday the water plant was bringing in the normal amount of water and functioning at full capacity. 10 March 2015

Water is now going through the system and tanks are beginning to get water again. The more we conserve the faster these tanks will fill and the faster everyone will have water.

The situation is a little different for those in the Millers Creek, Pryse, Fitchburg and Cobhill areas. A main water line that runs across the river has broken. This area has been without water since last Thursday night. The water companies are working as fast as they can to get a new line in. With river flooding last week in hindered their ability to even assess the situation. A contractor will be here this afternoon or early tomorrow to begin construction of a new line.

Simple ways to conserve water are:

- Turn the tap off when you brush your teeth. Just by

turning off the tap while you brush your teeth in the morning and before bedtime, you can save up to 8 gallons of water!

- Take a shower. Taking a shower uses much less water than filling up a bathtub. A shower only uses 10 to 25 gallons, while a bath takes up to 70 gallons!

- Fix that leak! If your toilet has a leak, you could be wasting about 200 gallons of water every day.
