Neal; her brothers: James, Raymond, Ronnie, Buel Jr., and John McKinney; and several nieces and nephews.

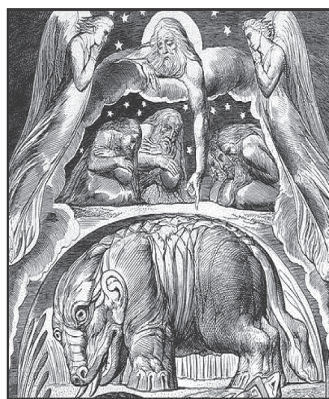
