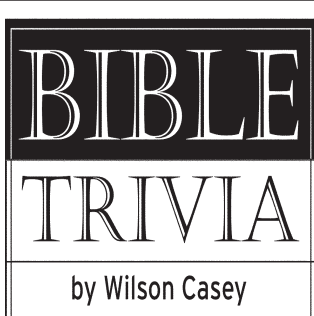

Religious Mutiny

Have you heard this English word, "mutiny?" It was given to describe the actions of unlawful, disobedient and rebellious men who rose up to defy the authority of the one who was in the leadership position of a ship, or army, etc.

Then, when I understood the actions of the word, I immediately thought to myself, 'This has been going on since God put Adam and Eve in the Garden.' After being placed there, the Lord gave them instructions to guide their actions on a day-by-day responsibility. Had they done this, no doubt, they could stay in this beautiful garden. But, Satan in the form of a beautiful snake, gained her attention and doing so he also was able to convince her that God did not mean all he said. Then, he was able to convince her that she would not die in spite of what God had already said. So, she partakes of the tree that God said not to eat, "lest ye die," and also gave to her weak-kneed husband and he also ate, thus bringing sin into this world, and death would be the result of their actions. **1 Corinthians 15:22**, "For as in Adam all die . . ." And so it continues even unto this day.

Notice if you will, that this action of mutiny that began then is still ongoing today. All through the Bible, men have been rebelling against God and Christ as in the beginning. In **Genesis 4**, after some time had passed, men began to offer a blood sacrifice unto God, but Cain rebelled and tried to offer a sacrifice that was unacceptable to the Lord. What did he do? He used his own idea that God would accept his sacrifice anyway. He committed mutiny before his Father and was punished accordingly, saying "My punishment is greater than I can bear." (Verse 13)

Then, many years later, mankind continued in the mutiny until God said it is enough and it caused God to be sorrowful that he had even made them (**Genesis 6:5-6**). Men who once enjoyed the blessing of God had now degraded themselves, indulging in sinful practices. So much so, that they couldn't have a thought concerning goodness. They grew more wicked every day. This continued on a daily basis. Finally, God determined to destroy all these people whom had turned away in rebellious mutineering. And so, God promised to destroy them with a flood that would cover the whole of earth, but God saw righteous Noah and his family still remaining faithful in spite of what unbelieving men were doing. So, he prepared a way out of the destruction that came. The eight obedient souls were saved and the rest perished.

So, God has never accepted the acts of mutiny and he never will!

Paul wrote in **1 Corinthians 10:11**, speaking of these Old Testament stories he said, "All these things happened unto them for ensamples: and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come."

The Bible is full of stories of men committing religious mutiny against God and the punishment they received because of it. But, sadly, they are continuing to do it even unto this very day.

So, don't be rebellious against the God and Christ who came to save you. Hear only him, believe, and obey only him and your eternal destiny will be secure.

There is, perhaps, no more reassuring picture of God's presence and protection than that of a shepherd leading and protecting his flock. That image from Psalm 23 brings us comfort and assurance whenever we face insecure moments when our lives are filled with uncertainties. It brings to memory the grace, goodness, mercy and might of our God.

In bringing Psalm 77 to a conclusion our author presents a picture of the Good Shepherd - the One who was with the children of Israel and of the One who could come as Redeemer and one day Ruler. He writes, "You led your people like a flock, by the hand of Moses and Aaron."

Can you picture what

he wanted those who read this Psalm to visualize in their minds? Seas writhing and convulsing, drenching rains falling from dark clouds that covered their path; skies that cried out and echoed with deafening thunder; flaming arrows flying above their heads; a whirlwind with noise and lightning; earthquakes that shook the ground under their feet. He wanted to remind them that through it all and in it all was their Creator-Sustainer-God who not only brought them into existence and would not let them perish, but had a plan and purpose for their lives.

Here then is what the Psalmist said to them then and is saying to us today: "Whenever life seems to be coming to an end it is only the beginning for My chosen. I am your Shepherd and will love you and lead you. You are mine and no one can take you from me! I'll always be with you."
