

Engineers finish 2019 with impressive 9-4 record

The Estill County Engineers lost their first game of the Dan Swartz Classic played at Bath County in Owingsville, but looked impressive overall after winning their next two games.

The Engineers fell by a single point to Elliott County in their tournament opener despite a 24-point performance by senior Joe Benton who led Estill in scoring and also in rebounding with nine.

Sophomore Landon Napier continues to improve and scored 13 along with 9 by junior Cobbe Click.

Individual scoring was not available but Estill won 56-46 over Fleming County and 64-56 over Menifee County to finish the 2019 year with a 9-4 record which compares very favorably to the 2017-18 team that went to the state. They reached the new year 7-6 overall.

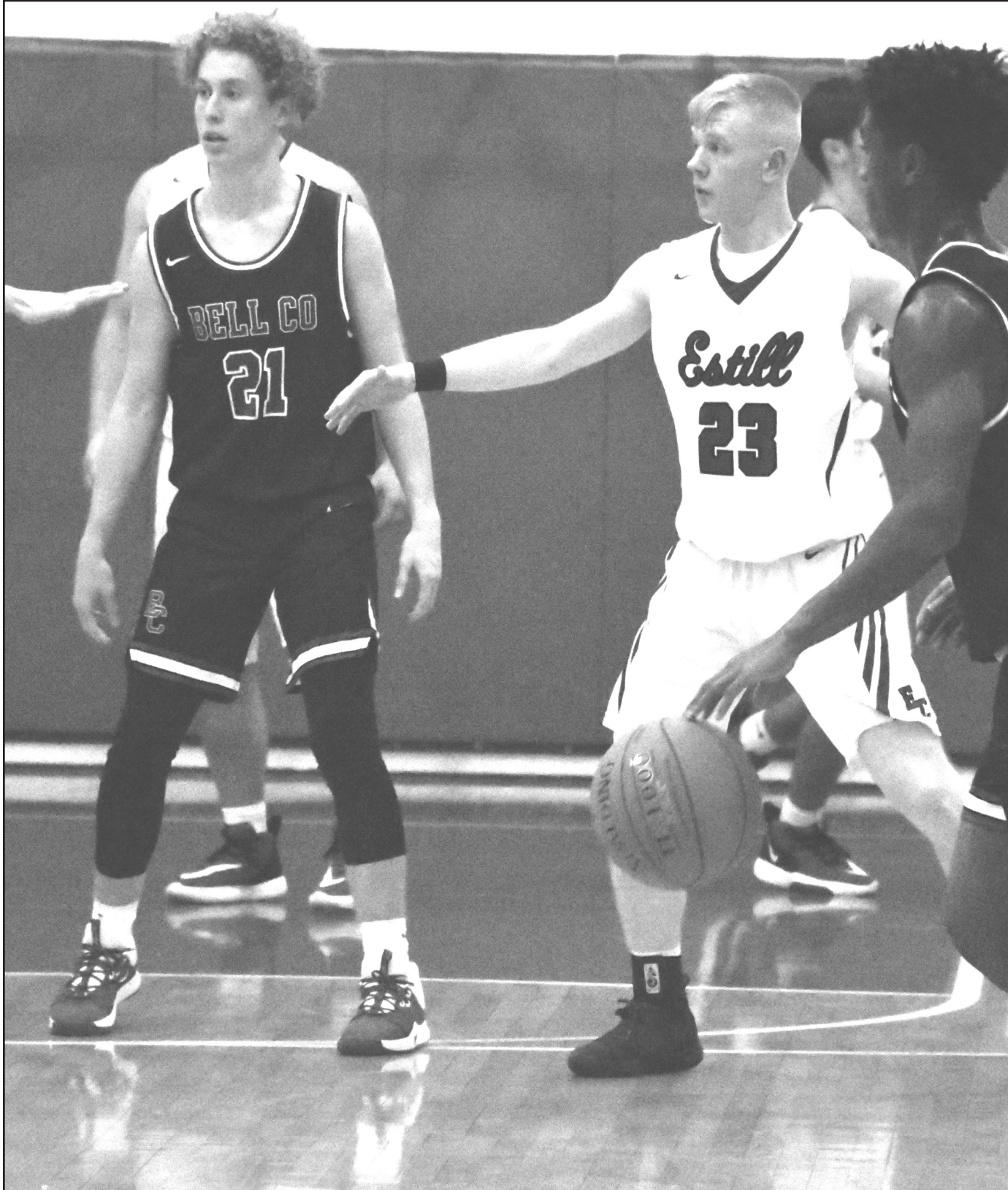

Estill's girls are 4-6 to end 2019

after going 1-2 in the Gateway Holiday Classic in Mount Sterling.

The Lady Engineers fell 39-69 to Martin County despite a 23-point performance by sophomore Mia Hale. Another sophomore, Hannah Baker put in 10 and grabbed six rebounds and freshman Haley Angel pulled down 8 rebounds.

Hale scored 15 in a 34-48 loss to Harrison County with eight rebounds. Eighth grader Sarah Baker got six rebounds and sophomore Maci Reed led in rebounding with 11.

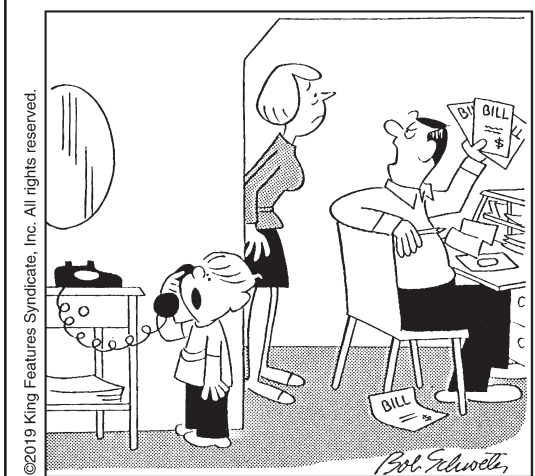
