 Flinchum also advised the council that city clerk Ashley Moore had to work 40 hours per week or make \$450 to be considered a salary paid employee, according to the law. Moore works part time for the city of Ravenna and holds another part time job.  
 The council agreed to not cash their checks for the month of January until Mayor Tipton was able to talk to legal counsel about the matter.  
 Horn said there were several homes within the city that had garbage piled up, and there were also a lot of leaves and debris littering the city. Council member Beverly Thompson agreed and said the leaves around 5th street and Poplar were really bad. Police

Chief Ken White said if they would provide a list of addresses, he would take care of it.  
 Mayor Tipton said that if residents would bag up their leaves the city would pick them up free of charge.  
 Ravenna will be celebrating 100 years in January 2021. Horn asked if a committee had been formed to start making plans for the celebration. Mayor Tipton said the historical society would probably organize something. Several of the council members agreed they would like to participate on the committee.  
 Howell said a public meeting would be held on January 27th at 5:30 to discuss the potential grant for the Veteran's Memorial Park.

 Gross said that he had received phone calls on two separate occasions from Junior Spicer about the parking along Church Street. He said that vehicles were parked on both sides of the road, and Spicer was unable to get the garbage truck up through there so he knew a fire truck would not be able to get through. The council agreed for the street department to paint the left hand side of the street in yellow paint and deem it "No Parking" in order for the trucks to be able to get through easily.  
 Two council members stated they would not be filing for re-election. Ernest Farmer and Derrick Muncie both stated they would not file for re-election even though they have enjoyed their time on the council.  
 Davis advised the council that a court had ordered an estate on Cantrill Street to pay the city \$2,038 to tear down the home. There was an agreement between the heirs of the estate and a neighbor who was interested in purchasing the property and tore the house down himself. Since the city did not have any part in tearing the house down, they will have to refund the money back to the estate. Davis said he was not sure when the money would have to be paid back but wanted the council to know about it.
