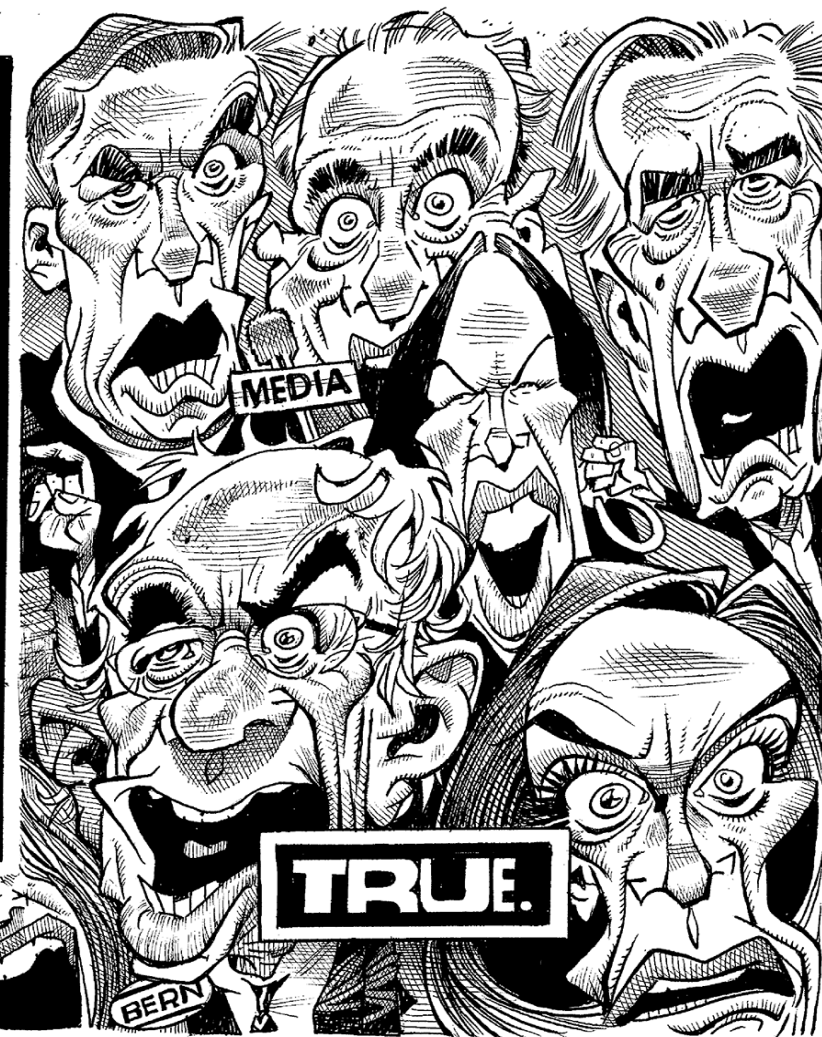

## Weekend storms cause damage across state

After high winds and dangerous storms moved across Kentucky and the southern United States this past weekend, over 9,300 members of Jackson Energy Cooperative were left without power.

The total number of outages reached 132 before the weekend was over.
