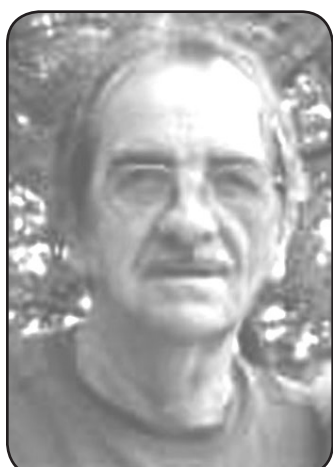

James Glenn Sparks, 58

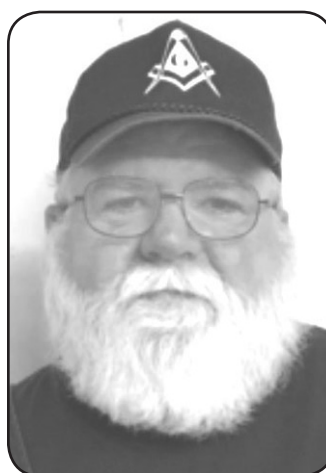
