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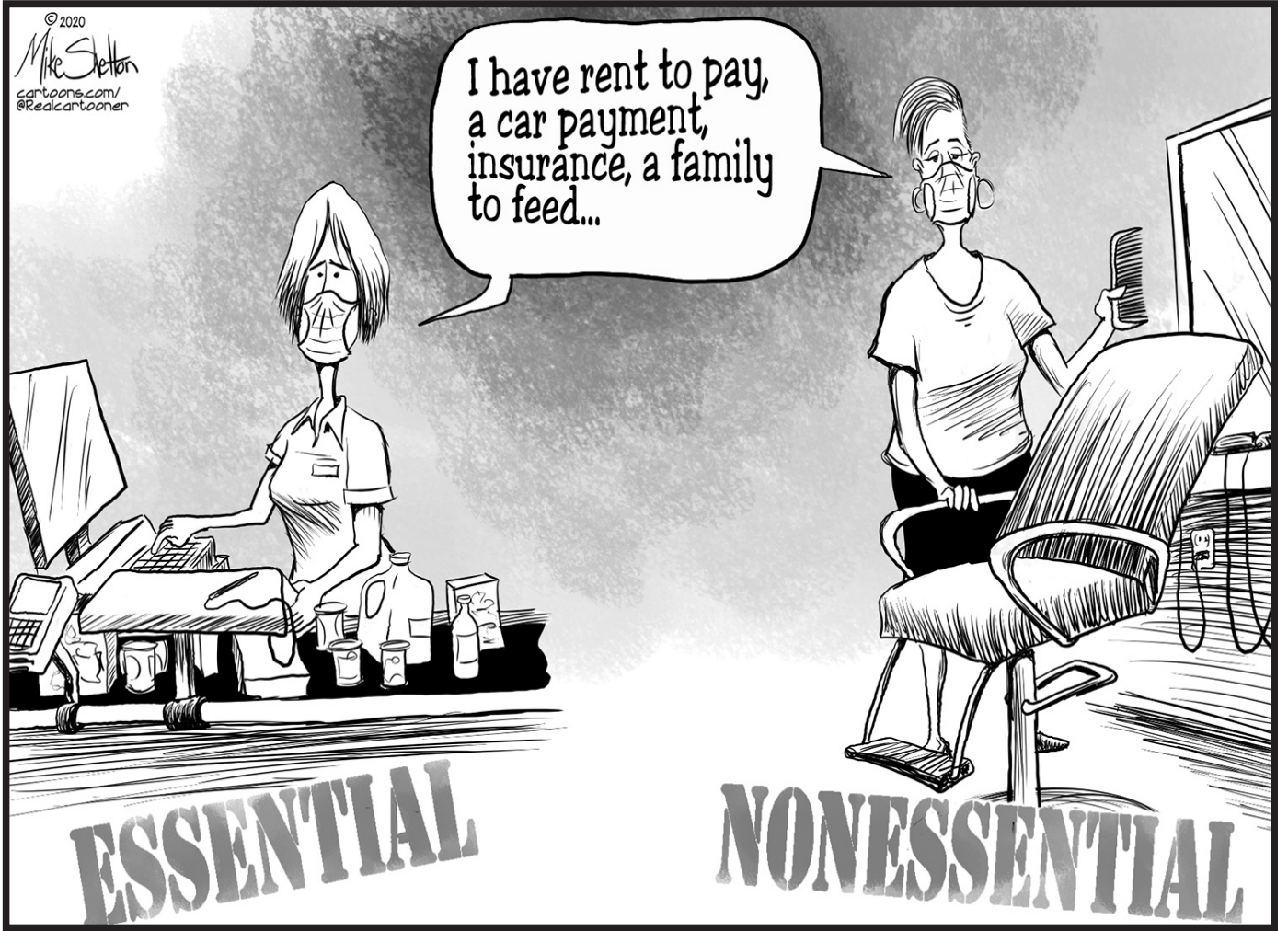

The other replies, "I could throw ten \$100 bills out of the window and make ten people very happy."

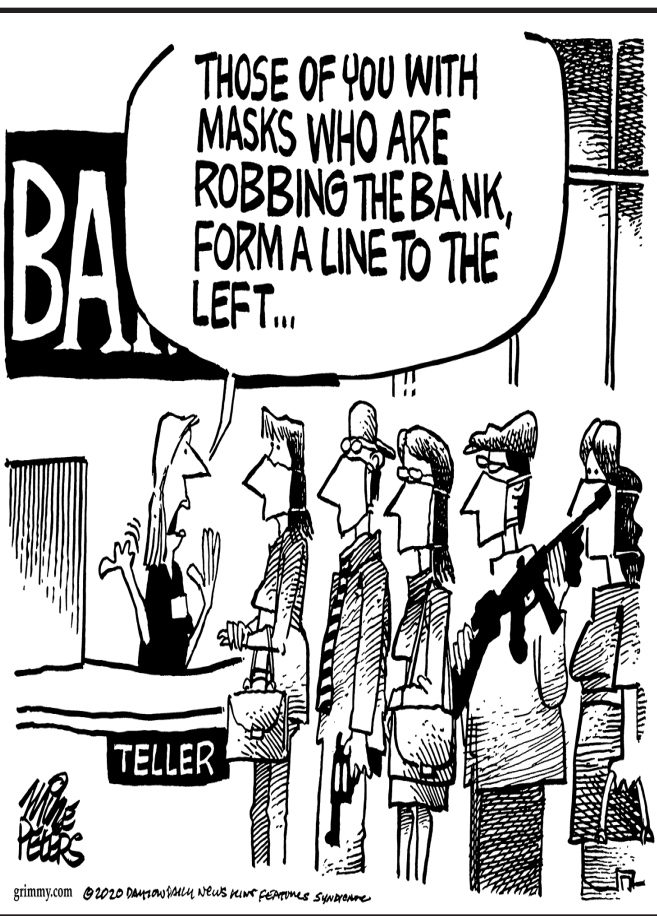
Not to be outdone, the first one says, "I could throw a thousand \$1 bills out of the window and make a thousand people very happy!"
