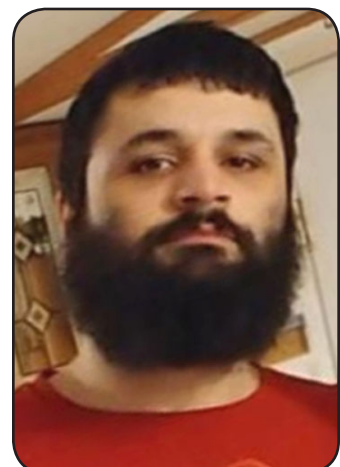
Jonathan A. Warner, 25
