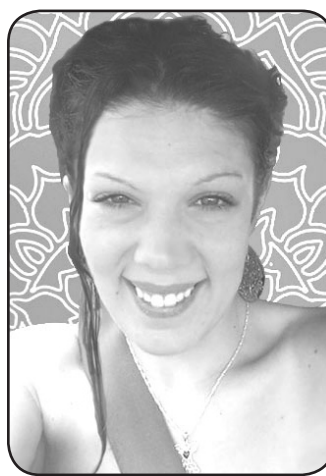
Sara Beth Underwood, 35

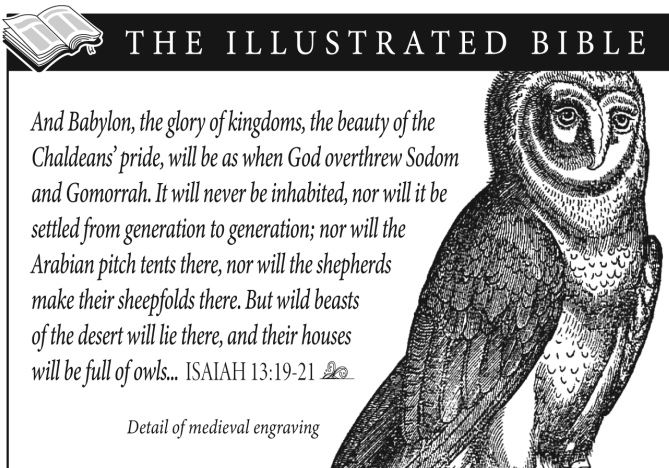
