After getting to know Frank, and Cathie, they told me, "Steve, we need to talk to you in private." I went outside with them. ## Estill County High School Athletics

### Fan Guidance and Expectations for the 2020-2021 School Year

#### Hoover Niece Field Attendance - Football/Soccer:

- 2 tickets per visiting player, 4 tickets per home player (pre-sale) - Fans **must** remain socially distant, with masks required to be worn for the duration of the contest.
- Each Estill County athlete will be permitted to sell 4 tickets per home game. Tickets may be sold to family members only.
- Tickets are required for admittance to athletic events. Fans without tickets will not be permitted to enter the facility. No tickets will be sold at the gate.
- Fan entrance for events (football, soccer) at Hoover Niece Field will be located at the gate between the greenhouse, and the football fieldhouse. These entrances will be clearly marked
- Fans must complete a COVID assessment, as well as temperature check upon arrival. Fans displaying any COVID-19 symptoms, or a temperature greater than 100.4 will not be permitted to enter the facility.
- Fans in attendance of Estill County Athletics event will be required to wear masks/face coverings at all times, as well as remain socially distant from other spectators. Families may sit together in an area closer than 6 feet, but they must remain 6 feet from other fans.
- Fans will be seated socially distant in the bleachers. If extra seating is needed fans may provide their own chair, and be seated in predetermined "boxes" in the 6th lane of the track.
- Limited "pre-packaged" only concession stand will be in operation.

#### Estill County High School Gymnasium Attendance - Volleyball:

- 2 tickets per visiting player, 4 tickets per home player (pre-sale) - Fans **must** remain socially distant, with masks required to be worn for the duration of the contest.
- Each Estill County athlete will be permitted to sell 4 tickets per home game. Tickets may be sold to family members only.
- Tickets are required for admittance to athletic events. Fans without tickets will not be permitted to enter the facility. No tickets will be sold at the gate.
- Fan entrance for volleyball events will be at the upper gym doors. These entrances will be clearly marked.
- Fans must complete a COVID assessment, as well as temperature check upon arrival. Fans displaying any COVID-19 symptoms, or a temperature greater than 100.4 will not be permitted to enter the facility.
- Fans in attendance of Estill County Athletics event will be required to wear masks/face coverings at all times, as well as remain socially distant from other spectators. Families may sit together in an area closer than 6 feet, but they must remain 6 feet from other fans.
- Home fans will be seated on the side closest to the Middle School, Visiting Fans will be seated behind the team bench area.
- Limited "pre-packaged" only concession stand will be in operation.
