## Hobert Osborne, Jr., 88

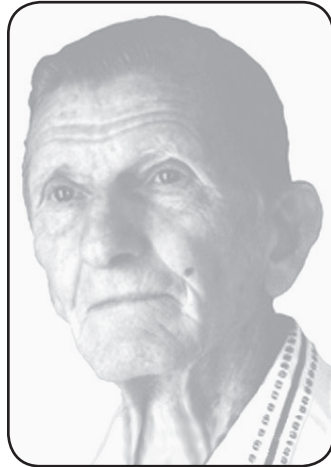

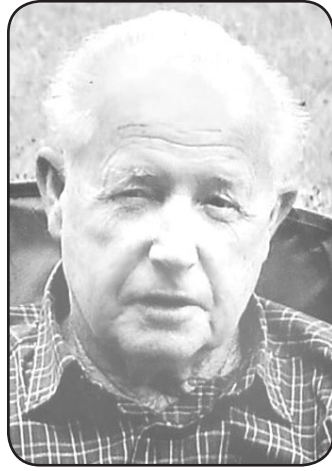
## Bro. William "Bill" Ross, 85
