Irvine Police charge man with trafficking in drugs after traffic stop Sunday

An Estill County man was arrested Sunday morning following a traffic stop on Crooked Creek Road, Irvine.

Officer Russell Morris was patrolling when he noticed a 1994 Buick Century with a loud exhaust and excessive tint on the back window glass. He was unable to identify the driver and conducted a traffic stop.

The citation states the driver, Henry Coffey, 40, of Crooked Creek Road, Irvine admitted his license was suspended.

Deputy Josh King arrived on the scene and conducted an open air search around the vehicle. IPD says the K-9, Penny, gave a positive alert for detection of illegal narcotics.

During a search of the vehicle, Deputy King located a pill bottle with no name on it. The bottle contained approximately six grams of methamphetamine, 15 gabapentin in 800 mg tablets, and one suboxone tablet.

Officer R. Morris reported he found a set of

digital scales. The vehicle was towed.

Officer James Marshall charged Coffey with operating on a suspended or revoked license, excessive windshield/window tinting, inadequate silencer (muffler), trafficking in a controlled substance, first degree and first offense (greater than or equal to 2 grams methamphetamine), possession of a controlled substance, third degree, and possession of a controlled substance, second degree.

Driver charged after K-9 alerts on vehicle during traffic stop

Candix Kay Johnson, 32, of Stacy Lane, Irvine was arrested early Thursday morning by Irvine Police Officer Stewart Morris on Richmond Road.

He said that Johnson was operating her vehicle on Richmond Road and failed to make a right turn into the Save-A-Lot parking lot without using a right turn signal. The back windshield was broken and had no visibility.

The citation states that during the traffic stop, the K-9, Titan, was deployed and alerted to the driver's side door. The

driver cooperated and consented to a search of her person.

Officer S. Morris said he found two small yellow baggies in her coat pocket. They contained a crystal like substance. He added that a digital set of scales with residue was found on the dashboard.

Johnson was charged with failure to or improper signal, improper equipment, possession of a controlled substance, first degree and first offense (methamphetamine), and drug paraphernalia -- buy/possess.
