The Main Cause of Religious Confusion

First of all, what is the main cause of religious confusion in our world? The answer should be very clear to the consistent Bible reader; when men accept the opinions of men above that which God and Christ have spoken through the written word; then, this is the result. Men form their opinions and then pass it along to those weak in Biblical knowledge, and the wheels of digression roll on and on. Satan did this to Eve within the Garden and he has not stopped his cunning, divisive ways even today.

Jesus says in **Luke 11:23**, "He that is not with me is against me: and he that gathereth not with *me scattereth.*" The word scattereth means 'to disperse,' also 'to cast down,' and 'to throw.' So, Satan through his subtlety, desires to have you so that he may grind you and sift you as wheat (Luke 22:31). So, then, what should we do to keep this from happening to us? Another thing one can do to avoid confusion is to "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." ^{2 Timothy 2:15}

This also we can do, remembering Paul's admonition to Timothy, "Take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine; continue in them: for in doing this thou shalt both save thyself, and them that hear thee." 1 Timothy 4:16 In **Luke 6:46**, it says, "And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?"

Then, in **1 Timothy 6:3-5**, the Apostle wrote, "If any man teach otherwise, and consent not to wholesome words, even the words of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to the doctrine which is according to godliness; ⁴He is proud, knowing nothing, but doting about questions and strifes of words, whereof cometh envy, strife, railings, evil surmisings, 5Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself."

With all this said, we clearly can see that we can decide what the truth really is when we read and study the Bible for ourselves. Subjects regarding one's eternal salvation are clearly seen in the Scriptures. The actions of worship toward our Lord, the proper day to meet together; all of these are clearly revealed to reading, believing students of the Bible.
