do not scatter the mulch until the soil warms. One precaution needed if you use straw is to be sure it is weed seed free. Otherwise, it will be a source of weeds for the growing season.

Most organic mulches will compact and start to decompose by fall. They can be tilled under easily, adding valuable organic matter to the soil.


